



# **Recipe Box:** Cheesy Brat Casserole

## **Ingredients**

- 6 fully cooked bratwursts, cut into 1/2-inch pieces
- 4 medium potatoes, cooked, peeled, and cubed (1 1/4 pounds)
- 116 ounce package frozen cut green beans, thawed and drained
- 1 10 3/4 ounce can cream of mushroom soup
- 1 cup shredded cheddar cheese
- 1/3 cup chopped onion

#### **Directions**

- 1. In a 3-quart casserole, stir together the sausage, potatoes, green beans, soup, cheddar cheese and onion.
- 2. Bake, covered, in a 350 degrees oven for about 45 minutes or until heated through.
